# Family Night

Our desire at Canyon Creek is to create a culture where people can grow in their relationship with Christ through study of his word and transformational relationships. Our world is busy and provides many challenges to our marriages, children, and friends. The balancing act of attaining all of life's joys and blessings can lead towards breakdown and unhealthy living. This is not the best of what God has designed for us.



Family Night is a ministry designed to help families take a pause in their week, and turn toward one another through the word and fellowship. We take these two things very seriously at Canyon Creek and believe in their power to provide restoration through right living. We desire to meet the needs of families by giving everyone a resting place where they can be served as a family.

A typical evening at family night involves three elements. First, we will provide a meal for everyone in the family. No pot lucks, no McDonalds, no Burger King, no In-N-Out (okay maybe we have gone to far with this one), but instead we would like to have everyone show up as a family and share in a meal together. We consider this not only a nice break, but also a very biblical concept and idea. Second, we will provide a Bible study for adults. This is a Bible study that will dive into the meaning of the text, but at the same time challenge us with pertinent questions about raising our families, growing in our faith, and building our relationships with others. Third, we will have a program for our children that focuses on getting some energy out of the system, developing relationships with each other, and growing in their understanding of how to serve their God and their family.

The money for family night is on a contribution basis. We attempt to have the evening pay for itself between the meals and the baby-sitting and the curriculum for the kids and adults. We will take a weekly offering and have a suggested amount for the contribution. ## Weekly Schedule and Meetings
