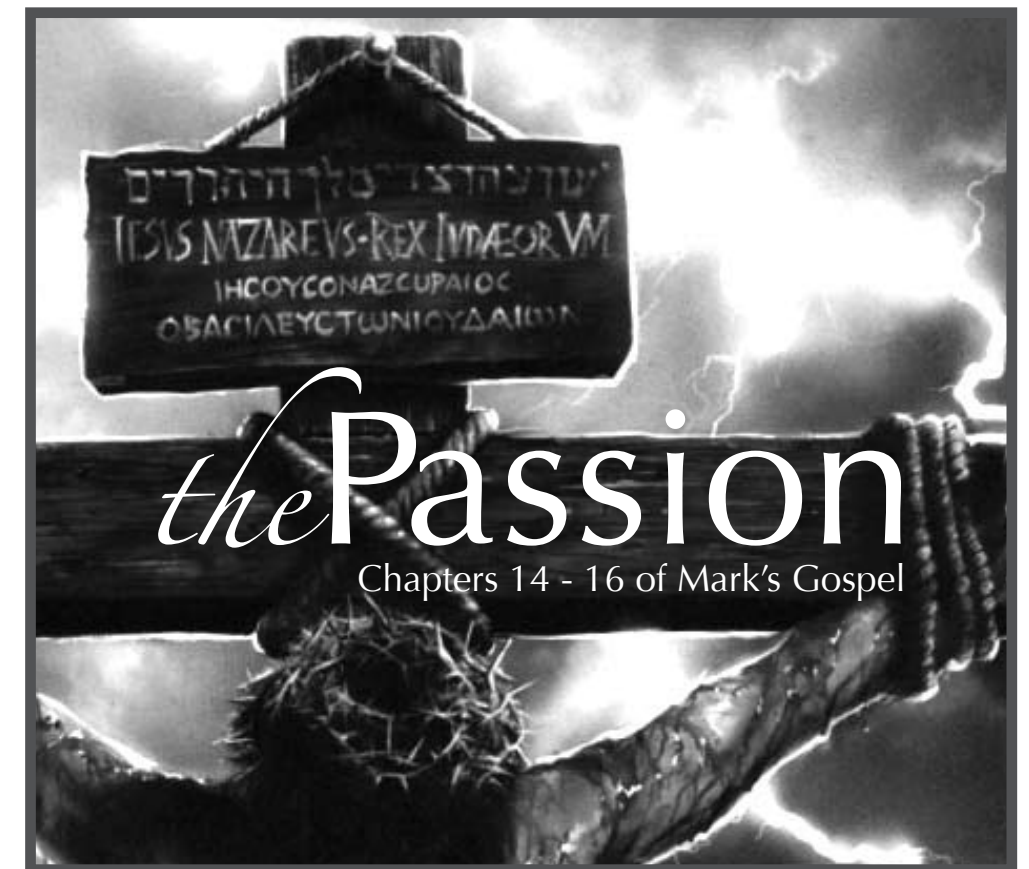

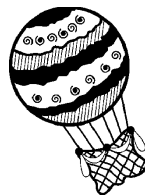
The students and adults will leave on April 5 to go to Mexico to build homes. Please keep them in your prayers.
