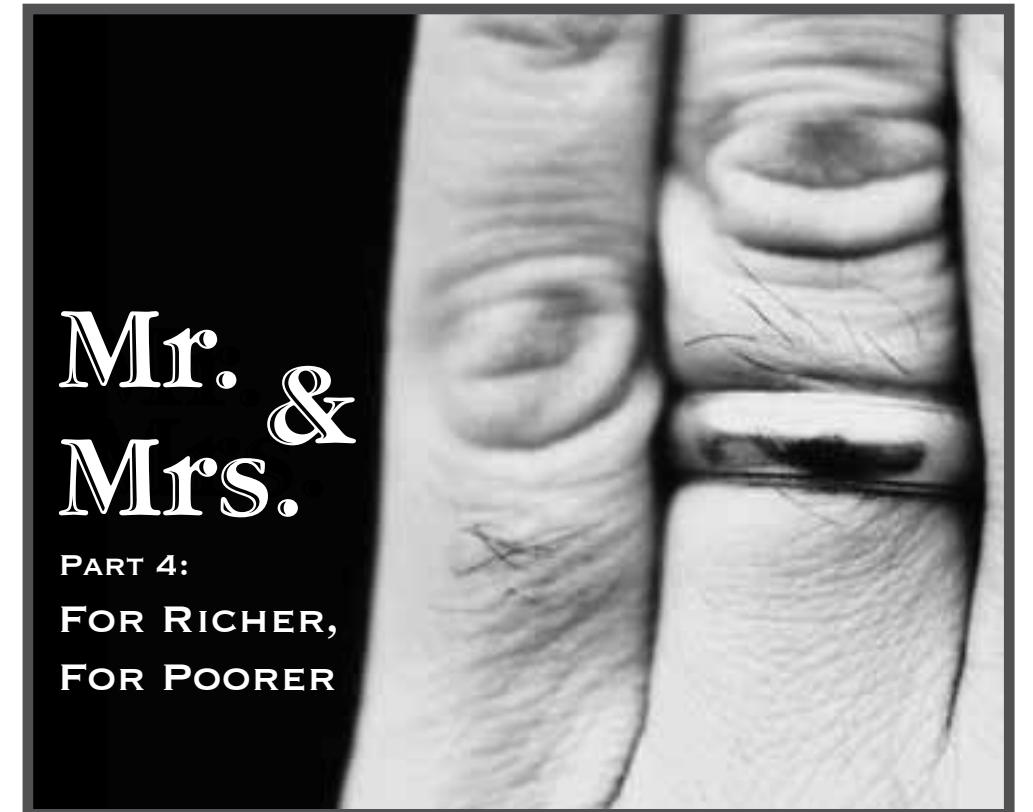

e-Scrip 10% Back To Schools

Reminder to shop now until September 15th to earn 10% on thousands of participating products. Everyone can participate, both registered and unregistered e-Scrip families.

Please notice the bottoms of your receipts which will indicate how much you have purchased in qualifying products. If you **are** an escrip supporter, this amount will automatically be credited to the group you support.

If you **are not** signed up for escrip, you will still be able to help us by bringing a receipt in to us or mailing it to us the first time you shop after September 15 (this time there will be a redemption code on the receipt). Only one receipt per family is necessary. Any subsequent receipts just repeat the same code which can only be redeemed once.

If you haven't already, please consider signing up for e-Scrip using the enclosed card. We must have your Safeway Club Card number (a phone number will not work) or a credit card or ATM number in order to sign you up. Or you can go online to www.escrip.com and sign up. It is easy and fast!
