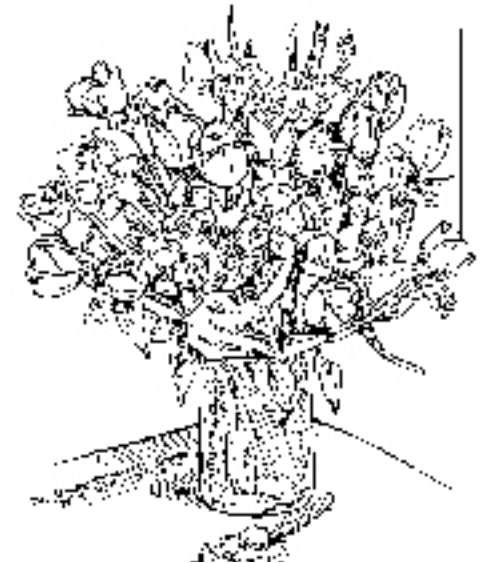

- Provide mentoring opportunities, particularly for the younger women.

FELLOWSHIP/EDUCATION

Women's Retreat - One weekend each March we get away from it all and head to a beautiful location to refresh and nourish our souls. A speaker shares Biblical truths from God's word sending us back home with new insights on issues confronted in daily life. Emphasis is on developing and maintaining friendships, laughter and straight talk about issues women face. We also throw in golf, hiking, shopping, relaxing and the Prize Patrol.

Women's Breakfasts - At varied intervals, women get together for a breakfast and inspirational talk by a guest speaker. These breakfasts are an opportunity for women to meet a new friend, encourage one another, be inspired and get connected within our church family.

Small Groups - Most groups meet weekly for Bible study, friendship, prayer and fun. In addition to coed, single and college groups, there are Women only groups. Whether you work in or outside the home there is bound to be a group that will fit your schedule. At present our women groups meet Wednesdays, noon to 1 PM., or 7:15 to 9:00 PM.

Mom's Group - This is a fellowship based group, intended to have moms of young children in the church connect and relate with one another. Mother's and children meet once a month to get to know, encourage and help each other. This group meets in the nursery, or at a park or on a field trips to a zoo or some other fun spot. Mom's get together for "MOM Only" dinner from time to time.

Friday Night Chats - Chats are for women of all ages and are just a fun and silly time catching up or getting to know other women. You don't have to RSVP but you do have to bring a favorite drink or snack to share. You can bring a friend, too. Chats are held the second Friday of each month, start at 7:30 p.m. and are held at someone's home. The place of the chat varies from month-to-month.

Christmas Brunch/Tea - Each year we celebrate the Christmas season with a brunch/tea. We may hear from an inspirational speaker, watch a fashion show, or see/hear a music program. No matter what the program, it is a wonderful opportunity to relax and visit with other women, to meet and make new friends, as well as a great time to bring a friend or neighbor to share in the celebration of Christ's birth.

SERVICE

Shepherd's Gate - We have teams that provide a meal to women and children at Shepherd's gate once a month.

Valley Crisis Pregnancy Center - Volunteer at the VCPC or participate in the walk for life event.

Caring Team - as part of the assimilation team ministry, women are encouraged to help provide meals to those in need due to illness, childbirth, etc.

Sisters-In-Service - a ministry working with local women in the most impoverished and restricted parts of the world.
